KIMBE, West New Britain Province

Wantok Radio Light had been unable to get permission to co-site on towers in Kimbe for over a year and we couldn't understand why. New Britain Palm Oil Limited allowed us to co-site on one of their company towers near Kimbe. During the installation we learned that the head of the engineering department, Peter Holland and his assistant, Thomas Agia, had become Christians within the last year. They were very willing to give of their time and engineering resources. What a blessing they were and the Lord's timing is always PERFECT!
